We love variations, and the card manufacturers have realized that. Each set released so far in 2018 contains an increased number of variations. The days of a simple photo variation are long gone! In this guide, I will go through 2018 baseball cards set by set and detail the different types of variations, print run/odds if available, and card codes to help identify variations. The trickiest part of variations is identifying them and making sure they don't get boxed up with commons. This guide will make it easier to identify a variation and how rare that variation is. As cool as it would be to do this project image-based, I don't think anyone wants a nine thousand page pdf. I will incorporate images when I can, but most of this will be bulleted and list information for quick reference. Cardboard Connection is a valuable resource for variation information, this guide will pull that information, along with Beckett's information, and have it all in one spot for you. This project is really to compile the information that is already out there and have all the info in one convenient place. I will update this guide after the information from new sets comes out.

Variation vs Parallel??

First thing to clear up is, what's the difference? A parallel is a card that is identical to the base but with a different color border, refractor, or other patterns. A lot of the these can be serial numbered. Parallels are always easy to spot. A variation will always contain something different from the base card. Usually it's a different image, nickname, or error. These also can be serial numbered, but usually a variation is just a "new version" of the base and are tougher to spot than parallels.



2018 Topps Series 1 Release Date: January 31, 2018


Topps Series 1 is pretty simple with variations, in comparison to the other sets. Topps sticks with Short Print (SP) Photo Variations in Series 1, but they seemed to feature more players with variations. 22 players also feature Super Short Prints (SSP). Topps did not include the variations checklist, making the variations more of a mystery and making it up to the collector to identify the different images used for the SPs and SSPs.

What to Look For?


Topps usually has a theme to their images used for the photo variation. This year the "themes" aren't very interesting or easy to spot. The SPs show players in batting practice/pre-game settings. Whereas the SSPs show the players using hand signals or gestures during the game. If you don't happen to catch the photo change, the fail safe way to check is by looking at the CMP code on the back of the card, small print at the bottom.



2018 Topps Heritage

Release Date: February 28th, 2018

Heritage seems to be a favorite when it comes to variations, due to the retro layout and how they mimic the original set. With that said, Heritage also might be the most frustrating of the sets when identifying the variations and SPs. A highlight of Heritage was the true photo variation of Shohei Ohtani. By true variation, I mean that this card actually replaces a base card in the set with the same card number. In this case it is Zach Davies, Card #17, A throwback to how variations started.

What to Look For?

Lots of things to look for in the Heritage set. There is a base card short print. These cards are easy to find because they are card #'s 401-500. They also do error cards that usually mimic the same errors from the original set that they are throwing back to. These are tougher to find, so it might be better to search the codes for the error variations. Throwback variations are usually a fun card to get. Easy to find by the image on the front with the player in their teams throwback uniform. Heritage cards throwback to an old set, most of those sets had still images of the players, Topps does a variation with an action variation. There are also team color swap cards, where the card design has a different color scheme as the other team cards in the set. This year they did an All Star rookie trophy variation where the year says 1969. There is also a rookie variation where a player who was on a dual rookie card, has a stand alone variation. Lastly, the nickname variation, which displays a players nickname on the front of the card.

2018 Donruss

Release Date: March 7th, 2018

Donruss jumped on the variation bandwagon this year with the amount of variations included in this set combined with how easy they were able to pull. Collectors have gotten used to variations holding their value, not in the case of 2018 Donruss. Too many variations in this set to seem like a special pull. Variation "subjects" doubled from the previous year. A great entry set for beginners in the hobby, or folks looking to come back and not spend a lot. Obviously the big drawback here is the no logos.


What to Look For?

One fun thing about the Donruss variations is that they are easier to identify than the competitors. Though the value may not be there, the instant gratification of pulling a variation might be. One thing I learned from Cardboard Connection was a "Variation Trick" for Donruss (image below). On the back of the card, there is a baseball graphic on the top left-hand corner. Variations will feature a black filled-in baseball graphic. The base will have a white filled in baseball. This shouldn't come in handy too much because of the other easy identifiers of the front of the cards. There are no codes to search on the back but here is the list of variations to look for.



2018 Topps Opening Day Release Date: March 14th, 2018

Opening Day has come a long way in the last few seasons. This set is a very inexpensive set to go after, and looked at as a beginner set, but they have been sneaking more and more variations and rare inserts into the sets. There are autos and relics in Opening Day, but they aren't what drive the set. They have added some really nice, and rare, insert sets to go with the SSP variations to give the set some nice things to chase.

What to Look For?

The Opening Day set is the identical design as the flagship Topps but with the Opening Day logo in a lower corner. The images are usually the same as the Topps set but in some cases they will use a new image. The SSP variations are all image variations and can be tough to spot if you don't know what the images are supposed to be. Like the flagship Topps, you can also spot the codes on the back of the card to identify a variation.

2018 Gypsy Queen Release Date: March 21st, 2018

Gypsy Queen looks to continue the variation craze that Heritage took to a new level, but with an added twist. They are offering new parallels to the base and the short print variations. Along with 20 Base Short Prints, collectors were a bit overwhelmed when the set released for all the goodies to look for. Mixed with a nice Ohtani base rookies, this set sky-rocketed in prices from its original release price.

What to Look For?

Short Prints. Parallels. Variations. And there's a lot to look for! The set features a Base SP that are card numbers 301-320. GQ features FOUR different parallels to track down. In addition, There are THREE official variations. It's easy to sort out if you know everything to look for. One thing GQ did make easy was that most of the variations come in the pack facing a different direction as the rest of the cards.

MISSING BLACKPLATE PARALLEL - worn out, vintage look. Odds not posted. Not rare.

MISSING TEAM NAMEPLATE PARALLEL - removes full team name in upper corner. 1:16 pack odds base - 1:422 pack odds for SP



Diamond Kings offers just about every kind of variation we have seen in the past and it makes for a really fun box to rip open. This season the big variation draw was that of Shohei Ohtani and his 8 different variants between hitting and pitching images, nicknames, and color changes. DK continues to offer a number of parallels to their set, all of the variations will come with the same selection of parallels.

What to Look For?

Fifty Short Print variations that feature Black & White Images, Sepia Images, Image Swap Variations, and Nicknames. These are pretty easy to spot, aside from the Image Swap Variation. Panini indicated a second trick to finding variations on the back of the card. Base cards will feature an oval frame around the players image on the back. Variations will feature a square frame around the players image. This is NOT confirmed to be the case for all variations yet, though.





No quirky themes in Bowman with the variations, just some good of fashioned image variations.

What to Look For?

These are tough to find simply because there are only two packs of the exclusive packs that feature the variations. The odds don't seem too rare at 1:69 packs, but it breaks down to 1:35 box odds since there are two packs per box. To take it a step further, they also do a Base SSP Autograph version of these variations. Those can be found at 1:853 pack odds.

Topps Series 2 is pretty similar to Series 1 with variations and layout. They are still featuring players in pre-game routines. Topps sticks with Short Print (SP) Photo Variations in Series 2, but they added two "Late RC SP" variations of Torres and Acuna. these cards are replacing a player's card number (always my favorite). The final tally includes 75 SP Cards, 25 SSP Cards, and 2 Late RC SP. One other wrinkle to the SP variations of this series are the Legend Variations that are replacing current stars. I.E Ty Cobb #351 variation is replacing the Bryce Harper


#351. These end in the same codes as a general SP. One cool thing about the Legend Variation, is there seems to be a tie between the legend and the star that they are replacing on the card. IE Don Mattingly replaces Greg Bird. Examples Below.

What to Look For?

As I mentioned, Topps did not change the "theme" of the variations from Series 1 to Series 2. This year the "themes" aren't very interesting or easy to spot. The SPs show players in batting practice/pre-game settings. Whereas the SSPs show the players using hand signals or gestures during the game. If you don't happen to catch the photo change, the fail safe way to check is by looking at the CMP code on the back of the card, small print at the bottom.

Optic is a "chromed" version of the base Donruss product, and usually it's a lot of fun to open. This set mimics the base Donruss set in a lot of ways but with the higher quality card. There are a lot of different types of variations to look for, but they should be pretty easy to spot and aren't that rare. There isn't really a method to how the variations are rolled out. They feature many different changes such as: Team Nickname, Player Nickname, Image, one Image/Nickname Variation and there is one Back Text Variation. Back Text Variation and and Team Nickname are both cool ideas to put in there.

What to Look For?

Donruss helps collectors a lot when it comes to identifying variations with their "Variation Trick". Simply check the back of the card and check the baseball that is above the card number. **White Ball = Base. Black Ball = Variation.** They do this instead of doing the different codes on the bottom. Thank you Panini! Here are the types of variations to look for in Donruss Optic. Ohtani features two card numbers. They list #176 as a variation, though there is no base card with it. Seems more like a bonus or extra card for the set. Not doing two variations of the #56 is interesting.
